## ORDER

Upon consideration of the Court's standing order filed on April 1, 2020, which, inter alia, deferred the requirement to file paper copies of briefs and appendices, and the current circumstances relating to COVID-19 (coronavirus), including the fact that the District of Columbia, Maryland, and Virginia have entered Phase Two of the reopening process, it is

**ORDERED**, on the court's own motion, that the requirement to file paper copies of briefs and appendices is no longer deferred.

Paper copies of briefs and appendices that have already been filed electronically are now due on or before Thursday, July 2, 2020.

Paper copies of briefs and appendices that are filed electronically between Monday, June 22, 2020, and Monday, June 29, 2020, are due on or before Thursday, July 2, 2020.

Paper copies of briefs and appendices that are filed electronically on or after Tuesday, June 30, 2020, are due in the normal course. See D.C. Circuit Rule 32(d)(4).

The remainder of the standing order filed on April 1, 2020 remains in effect.
