NOTICE OF PROPOSED CIRCUIT RULE CHANGE AND OPPORTUNITY FOR COMMENT

Notice is hereby given that the court, pursuant to D.C. Circuit Rule 47, proposes an amendment to Circuit Rule 24. The principal change is to require the filing of an appendix in cases in which the appellant or petitioner is proceeding in forma pauperis (IFP) and is represented by counsel or assisted by an amicus curiae appointed by the court. Corresponding changes to the Circuit's Handbook of Practice and Internal Procedures will be made.

Currently, Circuit Rule 24 dispenses with an appendix in all IFP cases. For pro se appellants or petitioners proceeding IFP, Rule 24 would remain the same: they would still be allowed to submit record excerpts in lieu of an appendix, should they so choose, and to file just one copy but encouraged to submit 4 if they are able to do so. If the appellee or respondent wishes to submit any additional record material, the proposed amendment requires the filing of an appendix, rather than additional record excerpts.

Under the new subpart (c), represented parties and amicus curiae appointed by the court must comply with the appendix requirements of FRAP and Circuit Rule 30, in IFP and non-IFP cases alike.
