ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING APPENDICES IN GUANTANAMO HABEAS APPEALS

Upon consideration of the government's suggestion that the court dispense with a public appendix in all the Guantanamo habeas appeals, which was referred to the full court by orders entered March 24, 2010, in No. 09-5331, <u>Al Odah v. United States</u>; No. 09-5351, Awad v. Copeman; and No. 09-5383, Barhoumi v. Obama, it is

ORDERED that, in appeals arising from habeas corpus petitions by detainees at Guantanamo Bay, standard briefing orders incorporate the following provisions, which may be modified by order in a specific case at the discretion of the Clerk or the court.

- The deadline for the government to file a public version of each brief will be four weeks after the classified or sealed filing.
- The government must file a public appendix that contains redacted versions of those documents in the joint appendix that the parties cite in the classified or public briefs and a redacted version of the district court opinion. The public appendix will be due on the same day as the public version of appellant's opening brief.
