


Description: Carpet Chambers 3108 and 5108

Date: January 9, 2015

Scope:

1	Remove the existing carpet from rooms 3108, 3108A, 3108B, 3108C, 3108D, and 3108F and dispose of it off site. See drawing below.
2	Provide new Milliken broadloom carpet, Sendal Broadloom: SEN15 Abalone, in rooms 3108, 3108A, 3108B, 3108C, 3108D, and 3108F highlighted in the attached drawing. Contractor shall prepare the floors and provide an adhesive that is in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations. Provide any miscellaneous materials necessary to finish the project.
3	Provide new Johnsonite "09 Clay", rubber wall base at all wall locations without fan coil unit piping covers or existing wood base indicated in attached sketch. Provide any miscellaneous materials necessary to finish the project.



Remove the existing carpet from rooms 5108, 5108A, 5108C, 5108D, 5108E, 5108G, 5108H and 5115 in the 4 locations shown on the attached drawings and photos.

Provide new Mohawk Group carpet tile, Brain Power GT136: 936 Technique, in rooms 5108, 5108A, 5108C, 5108D, 5108E, 5108G, 5108H and 5115. See attached drawings. Contractor shall prepare the floors and provide an adhesive that is in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations. Provide any 5 miscellaneous materials necessary to finish the project.

Terms:

1	Work shall take place on weekends.
2	Contractor to submit name, date of birth, and social security number of all workers that will be working on site for this work scope. Submit information after being notified that the proposal has been accepted by the courts. A background check will be performed against the information provided. A purchase order will be issued upon notification that workers are suitable to work, unescorted, in the courthouse. Should it be determine that workers are not suitable a purchase order will not be issued. In this event, an explanation will not be provided; all decisions are final. <u>Not applicable to workers who have already been cleared to work in the building in the preceding six months.</u>
3	Contractors shall work in assigned space only. Contact Scott Ellermets at 202.216.7351 or Justine Birrane 202.216.7354 for escorted access to and from the work location while working and if the contractor wants to view the space prior to submitting a quotation.
4	Contractor shall take all necessary steps to protect the existing space, typically including plastic protection over nearby surfaces. Contractor shall move furniture and equipment as necessary to complete work. The courts shall move computers, phones, and electronic equipment as necessary.
5	The contractor shall follow all relevant OSHA requirements. Safety glasses, long pants, short-sleeve shirts (as a minimum) and appropriate footwear shall be worn at all times.
6	Provide proposal no later than January 26, 2015.
7	Complete work no later than March 9, 2015
