Notice of Committee Vacancies

March 10, 2011

The court will be filling vacancies on its committees for three-year terms that start on July 1, 2011. A member of the bar interested in being considered for an appointment should submit a resume by April 12, 2011, to sgallagher@cadc.uscourts.gov.

Advisory Committee on Admissions and Grievances

The committee assists the court with acting on applications for admission to the court's bar and acting on complaints of misconduct or neglect. The court may refer to the committee any accusation or suggestion of professional misconduct or neglect by any member of the bar of the court. The committee may conduct an investigation as the court deems advisable. In addition, the committee investigates and recommends action on problems that arise in connection with applications for admission to the bar of the court. The committee will have four vacancies. The three committee members whose first terms are expiring are eligible to be considered for reappointment.

Advisory Committee on Procedures

The committee studies the rules and internal operating procedures of the court and makes recommendations to the court. The committee will have five vacancies. The three committee members whose first terms are expiring are eligible to be considered for reappointment.

Criminal Justice Act (CJA) Panel Committee

The committee annually examines the CJA list to assure that it is current and that its members are qualified. The committee also reviews the operation and administration of the CJA list over the preceding year and recommends to the court appropriate changes regarding the appointment process and panel management. The committee vacancy is for an experienced criminal law practitioner who is not on the CJA list.
