Public Advisory - May 24, 2017 En Banc Oral Argument in Nos. 15-1345, Raymond J. Lucia Companies, Inc. v. SEC, and 15-1177, PHH Corporation v. CFPB

Argument Date & Time: Wednesday, May 24, 2017, 9:00 A.M.

Courtroom: Oral arguments will be heard in Courtroom 20 on the Sixth Floor. There will be a 15 minute recess between oral arguments. Anyone leaving the courtroom between the cases may lose his/her seat.

Overflow Courtroom(s): An audio-video feed of the argument will be broadcast to an overflow courtroom (to be announced), if needed. All rules pertaining to Courtroom 20 (e.g., use of electronic devices) apply to the overflow courtrooms as well.

Public Seating: Public seating will be on a first-come, first-seated basis.

Reserved Media Seating: There will be a limited number of seats set aside for the media. Media will be seated on a first-come, first-seated basis until all the media seating is filled. Media representatives must then use the public seating line. Only members of the media who are credentialed by either the District Court or the Court of Appeals or who are credentialed by another federal or D.C. government entity, may stand in this line.

Reserved Seating for the Parties: There will be a limited number of seats set aside for the arguing attorneys. Each arguing attorney has assigned a point of contact to handle the reserved seating for his or her side.

Line Standers: Only individuals who actually plan to attend argument will be allowed to line up inside the courthouse for the arguments. "Line standers" will not be permitted.

Courthouse Entrances: Due to the 9:00 A.M. argument time and the crowds expected, the 3rd Street Entrance and the John Marshall Park Entrance will open to the public at 7:00 A.M.

Security Screening: Individuals seeking to attend the arguments must have a government-issued photo ID and allow sufficient time to pass through security screening. For more information, see our Security Screening policy on our internet site.

Use of Electronic Devices: All visitors are expected to follow the <u>Electronic Device Policy</u> of the Court.
