The Judicial Conference of the District of Columbia Circuit will be filling at least four vacancies on its Standing Committee on Pro Bono Legal Services for three-year terms that start on July 1, 2021.

The committee is comprised of 10 members who serve three-year terms. After serving one term, members are eligible for reappointment to an additional three-year term.
