ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON PROCEDURES UNITED STATES COURT OF APPEALS

July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2024

The committee is charged under 28 U.S.C. § 2077(b) with studying the rules and internal operating procedures of the Court of Appeals and making recommendations to the court on possible improvements. The committee is specifically authorized to design projects and to undertake studies on matters affecting the administration of justice in the circuit, either at the request of the court or on its own initiative. The Advisory Committee on Procedures also serves as liaison between the court and the bar.

The committee consists of not less than 15 members of the bar who serve three-year terms staggered in such a way as to enable the court to appoint or reappoint one-third of the committee each year. The court has endeavored to appoint a balanced committee membership reflecting various interests within the bar. Judge Gregory G. Katsas serves as liaison judge to this committee.
