NOTICE OF FINAL RULE

Pursuant to D.C. Circuit Rule 47, the court proposed amendments to Circuit Rule 35 regarding the time limits for filing a petition for panel or en banc rehearing to conform to changes to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 40, which will become effective on December 1, 2011. The proposed amendments were published for public comment on September 26, 2011. No comments were received. The court has ordered that the amendments be adopted effective December 1, 2011. Modifications to the Circuit's Handbook of Practice and Internal Procedures will also become effective on that date. Those changes correspond to the impending amendments to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 40 as well as amendments to Federal Rule 4, regarding the time limits for appealing a district court judgment in a civil case.
