NOTICE OF PROPOSED CIRCUIT RULE CHANGE AND OPPORTUNITY FOR COMMENT

Notice is hereby given that the court, pursuant to D.C. Circuit Rule 47, proposes an amendment to Circuit Rule 28(a)(2). This amendment would make it optional for litigants to add asterisks to mark "principal authorities" in a brief's table of authorities. Even though the marking of "principal authorities" would no longer be mandatory, the remainder of the rule is unchanged: the table of authorities "must identify each page of the brief on which an authority is cited, and the use of '*passim*' or similar terms is barred."

A corresponding change to the Circuit's Handbook of Practice and Internal Procedures will be made.
