## NOTICE OF PROPOSED CIRCUIT RULE CHANGE AND OPPORTUNITY FOR COMMENT

Notice is hereby given that the court, pursuant to D.C. Circuit Rule 47, proposes an amendment to Circuit Rule 35 regarding the time limits for filing a petition for panel or en banc rehearing.

The proposed amendments to Circuit Rule 35 are made to conform to expected changes to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 40, which the Supreme Court has approved, and which we anticipate will become effective on December 1, 2011. Changes to the Circuit's Handbook of Practice and Internal Procedures will be made to correspond to the impending amendments to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 40 as well as amendments to Federal Rule 4, regarding the time limits for appealing a district court judgment in a civil case.
