Circuit Rule 28

Briefs

(a) Contents of Briefs: Additional Requirements. Briefs for an appellant/petitioner and an appellee/respondent, and briefs for an intervenor and an amicus curiae, must contain the following in addition to the items required by FRAP 28:

* * * * *

(2) **Principal Authorities** <u>Table of Authorities</u>. In the left-hand margin of the table of authorities in all briefs, an asterisk <u>must may</u> be placed next to those authorities on which the brief principally relies, together with a notation at the bottom of the first page of the table stating: "Authorities upon which we chiefly rely are marked with asterisks." <u>If there are no such authorities</u>, the notation must so state. Even though the marking of "principal authorities" is optional, <u>Tthe</u> table of authorities must identify each page of the brief on which the authority is cited; *passim* or similar terms may not be used.
