NOTICE TO ALL ELECTRONIC FILERS OF CM/ECF GATEWAY IP ADDRESS CHANGES

The Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts (AO) began switching Data Centers from Sprint to AT&T on November 20, 2010. As a result, the CM/ECF gateway IP addresses have changed and some users may experience an interruption in the receipt of electronic Notices of Docket Activity (NDAs).

To ensure the legal community continues receiving NDAs, we recommend asking your Internet Service Providers (ISPs) to add the new IP addresses to their e-mail white lists. Your mail system administrator or automation staff should be able to assist you with contacting your ISP to ensure there is no interruption in mail service from the court's CM/ECF system. The AO Postmaster has already notified the larger ISPs (such as Hotmail and Yahoo).
