ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the district court's April 24, 2018 order be affirmed. After notice and an opportunity to respond to the court's order to show cause, the district court acted within its discretion in enjoining Anthony Ray Jenkins from proceeding in forma pauperis in the district court based on the court's determination that his persistent filings of frivolous complaints are harassing to the court. <u>See</u> 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a); <u>Hurt v.
