<u>JUDGMENT</u>

This appeal was considered on the record from the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, appellant's motion to expedite and memorandum of law, and the government's motion for summary affirmance. The court has determined that the issues presented occasion no need for an opinion. <u>See</u> Fed. R. App. P. 36; D.C. Cir. Rule 36(b). It is

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the district court's December 14, 2015 ruling, denying appellant's motion to vacate the magistrate judge's pretrial detention order, be affirmed. Appellant was indicted for an offense that triggers a statutory presumption in favor of detention. <u>See</u> 18 U.S.C. § 3142(e)(3). Although appellant presented some rebuttal evidence, the district court did not clearly err in concluding that no condition or combination of conditions would reasonably assure the safety of the community in the event of his release. <u>Id. § 3142(e); see also United States v. Smith</u>, 79 F.3d 1208, 1211 (D.C. Cir. 1996) (per curiam). Appellant's remaining arguments regarding the constitutionality of the Bail Reform Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3141 <u>et seq.</u>, and his objections to the grand jury proceedings, are without merit. <u>See Smith</u>, 79 F.3d at 1211; <u>see also United States v. Raddatz</u>, 477 U.S. 667, 683 (1980).
