NOTICE OF AMENDMENTS TO THE FEDERAL RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE AND THE D.C. CIRCUIT RULES AND HANDBOOK

Amendments to Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure 32, 35, 40, and the Appendix took effect on December 1, 2024. Counsel and litigants are advised to consult the substantive amendments to FRAP 40, concerning petitions for panel rehearing, rehearing *en banc*, and initial hearing *en banc*. The contents of FRAP 35, which previously governed petitions for *en banc* proceedings, have been transferred to FRAP 40. Conforming amendments to Circuit Rules 26.1, 29, 35, and 40 have been made.

Changes to the Circuit's Handbook of Practice and Internal Procedures, to conform with the rules and on various other topics, will also become effective on December 12, 2024. A revised version of the Federal and Circuit Rules and the Handbook, as well as a redlined version of the new Circuit Rules, will be posted on the court's website.
